BULK ITEM INFO

IF YOU HAVE A LARGE ITEM DUNCAN DISPOSAL CAN HELP YOU OUT IN MOST CASES. THERE ARE ADDITIONAL CHARGES WHICH APPLY WHICH CAN BE FOUND AT GETDUNCAN.COM/BULK-ITEM-INFO. THERE IS NO NEED TO CALL AHEAD, WE WILL GET THE ITEM(S) REMOVED AND THE CHARGE WILL BE BILLED DIRECTLY TO YOU. WE ASK THAT ITEMS BE BROKEN DOWN INTO PIECES SMALLER THAN 5 FEET IN LENGTH AND LESS THAN 80LBS TO PROTECT OUR CREWS AND TRUCKS.

TIPS TO SAVE

REUSE BULK ITEMS

- BEFORE THROWING YOUR ITEM AWAY SEE
 IF IT CAN BE DONATED OR GIVEN AWAY
 RECYCLE BULK ITEMS
- IF YOU SET A LARGE ITEM OUT A DAY EARLY
 METAL RECYCLERS WILL MOST LIKELY PICK
 IT UP BEFORE WE GET THERE
- WHEN YOU BUY A NEW APPLIANCE THE DELIVERY CREW WILL USUALLY TAKE YOUR OLD APPLIANCE AWAY

RECYCLING INFO

DUNCAN DISPOSAL HAS ALWAYS TRIED TO MAKE RECYCLING BOTH AFFORDABLE AND CONVENIENT. WE COLLECT RECYCLING EVERY OTHER WEEK AND ALL THE MATERIALS THAT WE COLLECT ARE KEPT SEPARATED FROM THE TRASH AND DELIVERED TO A MATERIALS RECOVERY FACILITY WHERE IT IS SEPARATED THEN TRANSPORTED TO THE PLANT THAT THEN TRANSFORMS THE MATERIAL INTO NEW PRODUCTS. WE KNOW HOW MUCH EFFORT YOU SPEND TO SEPARATE YOUR RECYCLING FROM THE TRASH—

WITH DUNCAN WE NEVER LET THAT EFFORT GO TO WASTE!



YARD WASTE

- YARD WASTE IS OFFERED THE FIRST WEEK
 IN ARPIL THRU THE LAST WEEK IN NO-VEMBER
- YARD WASTE INCLUDES BULK LEAVES, GRASS CLIPPINGS, BRUSH, WEEDS AND LOGS UNDER 2 INCHES IN DIAMETER
- PER STATE LAW ALL YARD WASTE MUST BE COLLECTED SEPARATE FROM THE TRASH AND DUMPED AT A COMPOST FACILITY.
- ADDITIONAL CHARGES APPLY

PREPARING YW

- LOOSE YARD WASTE MUST BE SET OUT IN COMPOSTA-BLE PAPER BAGS OR IN GARBAGE CANS MARKED YW
- THE COMPOSTABLE PLASTIC BAGS ARE NOT ACCEPTED
- PLEASE BUNDLE BRANCHES AND OTHER LONG ITEMS INTO BUNDLES THAT ARE LESS THAN 4 FEET IN LENGTH AND LESS THAN 20 POUNDS
- COMPOST BAGS WITH WET BOTTOMS RIP OPEN AND CAUSE A MESS— PLEASE TRY TO KEEP THE BAGS DRY!
